## "The Powerful Gift of Real Friendship"

Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: <u>but I have called you friends</u>; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you. **John 15:15** 

The Bible has much to say about relationships. Let's think about some of them. God had a relationship with Adam and Eve. David and Jonathan had a relationship with each other. Jesus had a relationship with His apostles. Not only did Jesus have a relationship with His disciples, but His goal was to show them the relationship that God has with them.

**John 14:9** Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father;

Everything that Jesus did was designed to bring light to the true heart of His Father who wanted man to have a relationship with Him based on "friendship." Abraham was called a "friend of God," and we are called "friends of God."

**James 2:23** And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.
