GREETINGS FROM ZAMBIA!



Hello Family & Friends!

One of the things that God has called Suzan and I to do is to work with ministries helping them fulfill their God given visions. One such ministry that we have been working with for three years is My Father's House in Zambia founded by Grace and Emmanuel Njobyu Kanegumbo. They have a multifaced vision, but their primary vision is to establish schools for underprivileged children whose families do not have the financial resources that are needed in order for their children to attend school. They are currently providing meals and education for 42 children in Lusaka, and 45



(The Children from the Lusaka school) children in Petauke, a village about 8 hours from Lusaka. In addition to this, they are launching another school in Mkushi which is another village about 7 hours in the opposite direction from Lusaka for approximately 50 more children.

It is amazing to see what God has helped them to accomplish since the ministry was birthed in 2017.

They are currently operating the school in Lusaka in a rented facility. But, have purchased a piece of land just outside of Lusaka where they will house the school once the facilities have been completed. It took almost two years to get the electricity lines to their property up and running. They had to drill a well. They were met with opposition and challenges. They are currently building a house for themselves on the property and are in the process of purchasing a block building machine so



(A Hug goes a long way-and they are Big Huggers) that they can make their own blocks to build the school and a wall around the property more cost effectively. After the school and wall are built, they plan on using the block machine to support a school run business that will serve two purposes. The sale of the blocks will help provide some of the necessary funding that the on going projects require. And, they will be able to use the block machine to teach future students a trade that will help draw them out of the poverty level. This year we worked together in Zambia for two weeks with John and Abi Elshaw from England who are very talented youth leaders. They conducted two youth seminars; one in Lusaka, (below) and one in Mkushi.

bia has been subjected to drought conditions this last year. Victoria Falls has dried up! That is bad enough, but Zambia gets its power from hydroelectricity that is generated by the falls. Every day ducted a pastors and leaders seminar in Lusaka in Lusaka, the power was shut off at two PM, sometimes before and it did not come on again un-riage confertil midnight. Sometimes they had running water in the house, and sometimes when it was most inconvenient, it just went off! It was HOT and there were no fans to regulate the temperature. The villages we traveled to have no electricity or running water. We slept on the floor and had to deal without the modern conveniences that we are all used
