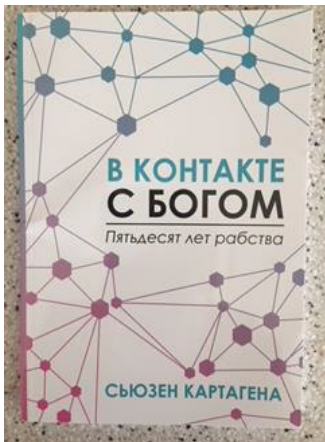

It's All in Your Imagination

It is hard to say 'Peace on earth good will toward men' when we look at what is happening in the world today. The trouble is we have spent more time in front of the TV than we have in the presence of The Lord, and we are looking at things through the eyes of the world.

God has prepared things for us that are beyond our imagination. We can't look at the things of the world through our natural eyes and expect to see them. 1 Corinthians 2:9-14 . Jesus said that we are not of the world just like He was not of the world. He prayed to the Father that He would not take us out of the world but that He would keep us in the midst of the world because we have a job to do! John 17:9-23

Jesus was the light of the world. The world is looking for light and we have what the world is looking for. The trouble is, we have been proclaiming a gospel that brings condemnation rather than deliverance because we have been reacting to what we think we see. We are like the salt that has lost his savor and the light that has been hidden under a bushel.

Jesus did not come to condemn the world, He came to glorify the Father. When people saw Him, they saw the Father. Sinners were attracted to Jesus. Publicans ate with him because they saw the light in Him. What do people see when they see us?
