We have been busy the last 3 months visiting and teaching in the CBC schools in Atlanta, and Macon Georgia, Birmingham Alabama, Raleigh North Carolina, Colorado Springs Colorado, Washington DC, and Toronto, Canada. Every school brought us to the same sense of awe as we stood in front of students sitting in the seats that we sat in only nine short years ago!



It was then that Mickey and I began a most incredible journey that was beyond the scope of our imagination! We started out as "ragamuffins" struggling with an identity crisis. We felt like we had no purpose and no future. At one point in my struggle before I came to CBC, God gave me a word of knowledge saying that He was going to do something *new* in my life and that I would stand in front of many people sharing that *new thing*.



He said "don't try to imagine what that will be now because it is beyond your imagination."

It has been amazing how God has brought us beyond not knowing who we were to a place of having a powerful God given revelation of who we are in Christ that can't be shaken. Not only did God set us free with that revelation, but as we share, that same revelation is impacting people every where we go. Who could have imagined!

God went out of his way to prove his faithfulness to us as He gave us words of encouragement that were divinely inspired. In 1988 God gave Mickey the desire to become a missionary. Many years went by without much seeming to happen. But as we look back now, God had the most incredible plan and all along God was equipping Mickey to fulfill that call. As we have seen that come to fruition, it has extended far beyond Mickey's imagination. How big is God!

While sharing in the chapel hour in the Colorado Springs CBC school, we used a scene from the movie Snow White to demonstrate Romans 8:6: To be carnally minded is death but to be spiritually minded us life and peace.

After we were finished a student came up with tears in her eyes. She said about a month ago on two separate occasions she was given a word of knowledge that she was like Snow White. She had no idea what that meant. When we used the mirror mirror on the wall demonstration, she knew exactly what that meant and her heart leaped for joy at God's unique approach to get her attention. She was looking in the wrong mirror listening to the wrong voice and and that was why she had no peace. How big is God!
