~NEW CREATION~

There has been much talk about the new creation. We say that we have been perfected forever. **Hebrews 10:14** And yet, we don't see ourselves perfected. The scriptures tell us that old things have passed away, but the old man with its weaknesses seems to be alive and well. Just what is the scripture getting at when it talks about this new creation?

For the love of Christ constraineth (holds together) us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead: Wherefore henceforth **know we no man after the**flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more.

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

2Co 5:14-17

Under the Old Covenant, man's standing with God depended on the works of his flesh. The New Covenant ushered in something entirely new. God no longer knows us after the flesh.

It is Christ that holds us together! He died for us and took our flesh with Him to the cross. The flesh (the old creation) is out of the picture because it was buried with Him. Romans 6:6

God is not looking at us according to our works. We are not judged after the flesh. I Corinthians 2:1-4

Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man.. ~John 8:15

The flesh has no value or place in that which is spiritual. We can't make the new creation about perfecting the flesh because it can't be perfected.

We have been born again. Flesh and blood don't determine the characteristics of the new creation. It is not about the flesh! The new creation is made up of the Spirit revealed Word of God. I am who the Word says I am. **John 3:1-5**

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Romans 8:6-8

Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

Galatians 3:3

It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life. **John 6:63**

The old creation is weak and temporary because the flesh is corruptible. The new man is incorruptible (has eternal life) because he consists of the Word that will never pass away!

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But the word of the Lord endureth for ever.
