

Typical Market Place in Zambia

Mickey and I spent the first two weeks in August teaching in Zambia, Africa. This was our second trip to Zambia and we were so blessed to see how much has been done since our first visit.

We originally met the couple that we are working with in the CBC school in Saint Petersburg, Russia. It was in Russia that Em-

manuel and Grace shared their vision with us. They felt like they were supposed to go to Lusaka, Zambia where Emmanuel grew up and start a Charis Bible College, establish an AWMI office, and start a free school for children who could



otherwise not afford to go to school.

When we visited Zambia last year they had just moved from Russia and everything was in the beginning stages. I have heard many teachers say that you know your vision is from God if it is impossible to achieve on your own. Well, this is a perfect example of that! Emmanuel and Grace just believed God and God alone is putting it all together!

In one year they have paid for the land where they are going to build the school called My Father's House. They have also paid to have a well dug and the electricity lines are in place. Although they have not yet built the building,

they have already started the school in a rented building. Currently they have 23 children enrolled in the preschool and kindergarten level. One of the teachers went with us to visit



some of the homes of children who are currently attending school. It was exciting for the children to share with us what they have been learning.

For your information, Grace and Emmanuel are using a program called Accelerated Christian Education which is based in the United States. If any of you are interested in helping sponsor one of these children, there are several options. \$1224 per year

or \$102.00 an month will pay all of the expenses for one student. This includes all of their school material, 2 meals a day, the teacher's salary and any extra outings or events. Another option would



be to just pay for the actual school supplies that a child would need for the year which is \$1000, or \$100 a month. If anyone is interested in this, please let us know and we will help you set things up through Emmanuel and Grace.

In addition to the school for the children, they are teaching Charis Bible College Discipleship Evangelism classes. The first group graduated in May and the second group will graduate in December. Mickey and I taught several lessons and we were im-



pressed with the energy and enthusiasm that the students who are enrolled met us with. They have students from various locations in Zam-

bia that have very diverse denominational backgrounds.

They also have several students enrolled in Charis Bible School on-line classes. It was so refreshing for us to listen to the student's tell us what God has been showing them and how much it is affecting


their lives.

An AWMI center has been established and they are currently distributing books written by Andrew Wommack in Zambia.

God told us that He would send us to the few that were ready to hear the message that He has given us, who would in turn affect thousands. This is certainly one of those places! Mickey and I always say, "We know the best people everywhere!"
