The second week in July, Mickey and I traveled to The European country of Lithuania to minister at a week-long camp meeting sponsored by Andrew Wommack Ministries. We were teamed up with Mike and Carrie Picket (Vice Presidents of Charis Bible College and International Operations of Andrew Wommack Ministries) and Lukasz and Ella Buchnajzer (Charis Bible College Directors in Poland). The theme of the conference was centered around developing healthy foundational spiritual truths that ultimately lead to experi-

Jesus had set him free and he was telling everyone and testifying of what God had done. After spending 10 days in Lithuania, we traveled to Egypt. We spent one week ministering in the Nile River farming communities and one week ministering in Cairo. Things were quite different there. All of and how excited they became as they began to the churches we visited, with the exception of one, seemed to have the same thing in common. They did free. not have a real grasp of the Word. The pastors were



preaching messages that were based on religious rituals and traditions of men mixed with both **New Covenant**

and Old Covenant principles. We found ourselves ministering mostly on the love of God and healing because those were the things that everyone was drawn to. We met some wonderful people and had some great services, but ultimately, we realized that nothing we said would produce any lasting fruit unless change began within the leadership.
